VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS - PAYMENT NOW DUE

Voluntary Contributions are collected from families and used towards meeting the costs of providing an educational program that meets the requirements of the West Australian Curriculum. These contributions are used to provide materials, services and facilities directly used or consumed by students, including the provision of text materials.

Payment of the contribution is voluntary and can be spread over time, and a range of payment options can be confidentially negotiated with the office.

The \$60 per student contribution is in line with the recommendations set in the School Education Regulations (1999) and we have elected to offer a discount on a sliding scale for:

1st Child \$60

2nd child \$50 (16.5% discount)

3rd and subsequent children \$40 (33% discount).

NEW CLASSROOM - KOOLBARDI

Our new classroom has finally been completed and Mrs Maddern and the Year 3 students are settling in nicely. This room will be formally named Koolbardi (Magpie).



TREE PLANTING - MILLION TREES PROGRAM (MOTT PROJECT)

Men of The Trees (MOTT) are active in growing and planting native plants in the Peel Region and are currently running a school-based tree planting program at North Dandalup Primary called the Million Trees Program (MTP). MTP is a very successful program which has been running in the Peel area for over 23 years and although the main focus is students' learning, there is a lot that goes on behind the scenes.

In early summer MTP volunteers sow a variety of local species and generate around 600 native seedlings per school. The seedlings are raised at volunteers houses on irrigated growing tables supplied by MOTT, and the growers are provided with support and guidance. When the seedlings are ready, they are taken to the school and cared for by the students until they are ready to plant out.

Then the MTP volunteers along with the staff and students of North Dandalup Primary will plant out approximately 600 native plants along the path south of the school. The plants and propagation process are utilized in the school learning curriculum, as well as stimulating an interest in native vegetation and restoration of habitat for birds and other animals in our community.

Who - All students in Years K - 6

When - Next Wednesday 24th July

Where - Bike path between North Dandalup PS and Town Hall

Students will assemble in their Environment groups on the basketball court at the start of the day. We will then head off down the path in our groups. After planting all our seedlings, we will return to school in time for recess.

On the day, all students will need to wear old clothes, gum boots or old shoes (with a clean, dry pair to change into) and a raincoat.

As this is a local excursion, there will be no permission note required for this day.

As this is the first tree planting adventure for our kindy students, additional parent volunteers on the day would be greatly appreciated. Please let the office know if you are able to assist on the day.
