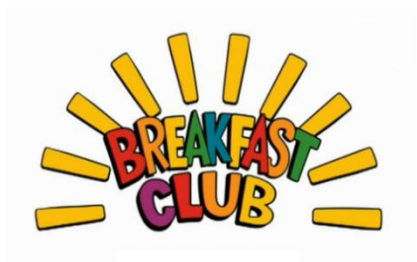
BREAKFAST CLUB
