
GETTING READY FOR KINDY 2022

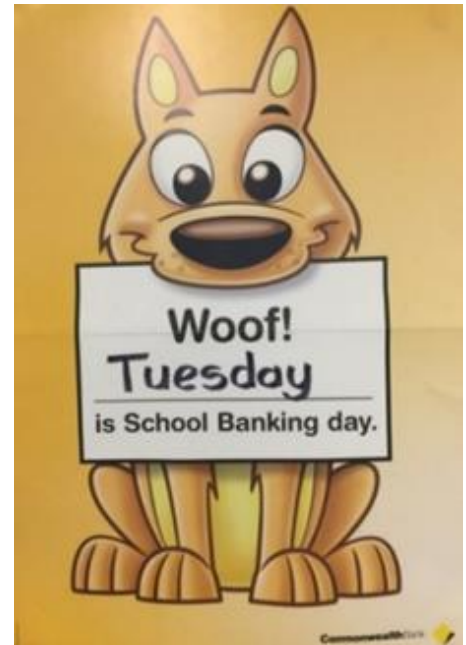
