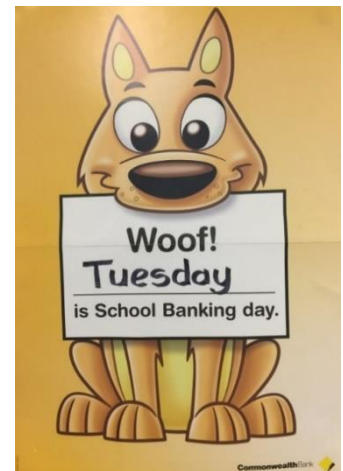
LONG WEEKEND
