The theme for Book Week 2021 is "Old Worlds, New Worlds, Other Worlds"



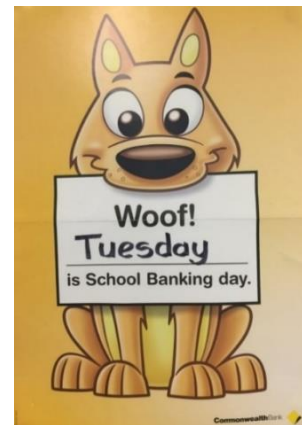
Download instructions:
